PROJECT REVIEW

1. CASE 18.101, 290 SMITH STREET, Portland Transmission Building (PLD-ICBD)

The applicant is requesting the demolition of the existing structures on the site. *This is a public hearing.*

2. CASE 18.103, 511-513 BROADWAY, House, c1920 (BROADWAY)

The applicant is requesting the modification of a window to a door and the construction of a wood land and steps and a metal ADA-accessible ramp, to the side, east, elevation.

3. CASE 18.065, 1492 WESTMINSTER STREET, vacant land (ARMORY)

The applicant is requesting the new construction of a 3-story, mixed-use building with seven one-bedroom dwelling units and a ground-floor retail space.

4. CASE 18.109, 131 CONGDON STREET, House, c1895 (COLLEGE HILL)

The applicant is requesting installation of parking space and tiered retaining walls over 3' at front of property.

5. CASE 18.110, 110 HUDSON STREET, vacant land (ARMORY)

The applicant is requesting the construction of new row-houses.

6. CASE 18.111, 111 HUDSON STREET, vacant land (ARMORY)

The applicant is requesting the demolition of a secondary concrete-block garage and construction of new row-houses.
