(PROOF OF A PROSPECTIVE ELECTOR BEING A CURRENT REGISTERED VOTER IN THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE SHALL SATISFY THE ABOVE REQUIREMENTS: OTHERWISE ONE SHOULD BE PREPARED TO PRESENT TWO FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION).** Nominations and voting will begin at 2:00 o'clock P.M. and end promptly at 4:30 o'clock P.M.
