An Ordinance Amending Ordinance No. 281 of Chapter 2014-12, adopted June 12, 2014 providing for the Assessment and Collection of 2014 taxes in a sum not less than Three Hundred Forty Million Eight Hundred and Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Twenty Two Dollars (\$340,814,522) and not more than Three Hundred Fifty Four Million Four Hundred and Forty Seven Thousand and One Hundred Three Dollars (\$354,447,103) being based on a One Hundred Percent (100%) of the 2015-2016 Fiscal Year Tax Collections, Amending Section 21-182 of the Code of Ordinances to reflect the Tax Classification Plan Approved by the Rhode Island General Assembly, Repealing in part Ordinance No. 348 of Chapter 2014-29, Amending Section 21-126 of the Code of Ordinances to raise the Personal Exemptions, and setting the rates for Fiscal Year 2016.

An Ordinance in Amendment of Chapter 2014-13, No. 282, Approved June 12, 2014 of the Ordinances of the City of Providence, Making an Appropriation of Six Hundred Seventy-Eight Million, Four Hundred Nine Thousand, Nine Hundred Seventy-Eight Dollars, and no cents (\$678,409,978), for Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 2015, As Amended.
