Resolution Requesting the Tax Assessor to cancel or abate in whole the taxes assessed upon Assessor's Plat 057, Lot 0079 (**182 Pavilion Avenue**), on behalf of the Providence Redevelopment Agency, in the amount Ten Thousand Eight Hundred Seventy Nine Dollars and Thirteen (\$10,879.13) Cents, and that the property is declared exempt in accordance with Rhode Island General Law 45-32-40 while under PRA ownership.
