1. Petition from Wayne M. Kezirian, Gaebe & Kezirian, 128 Dorrance Street, Providence, Rhode Island 02903 on behalf of Johnson & Wales University, requesting to abandon a portion of Foster Street.
2. Resolution Requesting to re-adopt Resolution No. 190 and 191, Approved May 17, 2004, relative to the abandonments of portions of Myrtle and Linden Streets.
3. Petition from Thomas A. Hanley, Esquire, Attorney for ProvPort, along with NEPT (The Hudson Companies), requesting approval to change the existing twelve (12) foot wide easement so that it may be converted from underground to overhead.
4. Petition from Kari Nel Lang, Executive Director, West Broadway Neighborhood Association, 1560 Westminster Street, Providence, Rhode Island 02909, requesting approval for the installation a permanent three-foot canopy over the twelve-foot sidewalk at 1577 Westminster Street.
5. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of a "No Parking, Loading Zone" Sign in front of Jessie's Restaurant at 230 Atwells Avenue.
6. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to amend their Rules and Regulations from "Parking within twenty-five (25) feet of corner" to "Parking within ten (10) feet of corner".
7. Resolution Requesting the Director of Public Works to cause the repair of the sidewalk located at 80 Hendrick Street.
8. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of "Four-Way Stop" Signs at the intersection of Alaska Street and Greeley Street.
9. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of a "No Dumping" Sign at the end of Prosper Street.
10. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of "Slow Children" Signs on Greeley Street, running East and West from Oppor Street to Hagan Street.

11. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause Tappan Street to be established as a “One-Way” Street, in a northerly direction from Admiral Street to its angle point at Tappan Street and the parking lot of the apartment building, to improve the flow of traffic.
12. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of a “Stop” Sign at its intersection with the angled point of Tappan Street to improve the flow of traffic.
13. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of a “Do Not Block Driveway” Sign on the Hawkins Street side of Patricia’s Florist.
14. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of “Three-Way Stop” Signs at the intersection of Farm Street and Webb Street.
15. Resolution Requesting the Traffic Engineer to cause the installation of “No Parking 8:00 o’clock a.m. to 10:00 o’clock a.m.” Signs along Transit Street between Brook and Benefit Streets.
