Board of Engineers Meeting

June 12, 2005

Meeting was convened by Chief Mruk at 9:30 a.m.

Clerk took the roll call, present were Chief S>J> Mruk, 1st Asst. Chief J. Hatman, and 2nd Asst. Chief Robert Warren.

The minutes of the previous session were presented and accepted as read.

Agenda

Chief Mruk reports on all work that was done on Engine 1 by the Twin Lights Repari Co. to date. More work will be done including oil leaks and priming.

Engine 2 had a complete service heck by Twin Lights. An inventory sheet of ewquipment on board was made. Items should be checked periodically. Engine tanks and foam supple valves were also checked. Hose testing and loading was done on both Engines. There is 600 feet of hose aboard Engine 1.

Engine 3 was also serviced with new oil and filters. Leaks were checked. Al engines were serviced by Twin Lights.

Chief Mruk discussed the procedure for hose testing and plans to test hoses during the week ahead. Chief states test to be made at 250 lbs. Pressure for ten minutes.

Capt. St. jean suggested hose laying flat pack on units in the beds. Chief Mruk will take under advisement, and the board will determine hose lay and type of foam.

2nd Asst. chief Warren read the test report done by members on duty. Capt. St. Jean listed 200 lbs. for 4 min. and 250 lbs. for 1 min. as the hose test requirements. 2nd Asst. chief Warren will post hose test

notices.

Chief Mruk reported on the Safety Committee. Board members must be in the majority. Members interested are, Pvt. R. Carlow, Capt. L. St. Jean, Pvt. K. Sprague, and Andy Banes. Ken Dicarolo is also interested. The Board will study the applicants and appointments and take them under advisement.

Chief Mruk reported on members being measured for uniforms, lite blue, short sleeve for summer use. The order is being awaited. 2nd Asst. Chief Warren is supervising the uniform agenda.

Chief Mruk reported receiving a notice that the Hopkins Hill Fire District is now in command of the Fire alarm full time dispatchers and are now workers for them.

Chief Murk motions to adjourn the session. Seconded by 2nd Asst. Warren and so voted unanimously. Time adjourned as 10:15 a.m.
