Daniel J. Smiley, violation #3575

Daniel J. Smiley and Ted Whittaker sworn in.

Ted Whittaker read the violation, On June 22, 2006, Daniel J. Smiley entered into a contract with Valerie V. Ranglin-Brown of 14 Geneva Street, Providence, RI to install new basement heating at the above mentioned location for the amount of \$3500.00. No permit was taken from the mechanical department with the City of Providence. This is a violation of RIGL 28-27-20-“State and municipal inspection and installation permits”. It has come to our attention that Mr. Smiley does not have a Master license to do mechanical installations as a properly licensed contractor. This is a violation of RIGL 28-27-5-“practice for which a master or contractor license required”, for a total of two violations at \$500.00 each for a total of \$1000.00.
