The Town of Westerly is considering filing an application with the State of Rhode Island for a Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for fiscal year 2011. A maximum of \$400,000 may be awarded to Westerly to undertake the following range of program activities:

- (a) Provision of employment opportunities to low and moderate-income persons;**
- (b) Improved housing opportunities for low and moderate-income families and individuals;**
- (c) Provision of community facilities and services that principally benefit low and moderate-income families and individuals.**

Prospective applicants are advised that a public informational hearing will be held in Town Council Chambers, Westerly Town Hall,

45 Broad Street, Westerly, RI on Thursday, April 7, 2011 at 4:00 p.m. to discuss the Town's program priorities, the application format, and application deadlines. It is the intent of the Town of Westerly to specifically pursue a comprehensive revitalization program for the North End neighborhood, which may consume a significant amount of requested funds.
