#### **Discussion of the following:**

**1) North Cape proposal to import clams that have been raised in a nursery setting in either Long Island or SE Massachusetts.**

**2) Dale has proposed the following question: What limitations should we place on seed shellfish that are infected with a specific disease in terms of moving them to areas that already have a history of the disease at the new location? Specifically, if we have a lot of seed oysters that have a low level of infection of dermo, is there any good reason to deny allowing the seed to be moved into an area that is currently demonstrating an on-going level of dermo?**

**3) The previous question also brings up the question of testing for seed importation for diseases that are currently endemic. Is it still necessary?**
