2006-04-101 EDWARD KRIETE -- construct and maintain a residential boating facility consisting of a 4' wide by 6' long ramp that leads to a 4' wide by 97' long fixed timber pier that leads to a 3' x 20' ramp that leads to a 150 square foot terminal float. The proposed structure is to extend 75' seaward of the cited Mean Low Water mark. Located at plat 26, lot 174, 160 Adams Point Road, Barrington, RI.

2006-05-131 TAVIT SMITH -- Construct and maintain a residential boating facility consisting of a 4' x 8' fixed timber pier, a 3' x 15' ramp and an 8' x 18.75 (150 square foot) terminal float. The proposed structure is to extend 25 feet seaward of the cited mean low water mark. Located at plat N-G, lot 15; 106 North River Drive, Narragansett, RI.

2006-06-020 SHAWOMET REALTY COMPANY -- Construct and maintain a 4 foot wide by 30 foot long timber footbridge with a ramp, the cutting of a 5' wide footpath, the establishment of a shoreline recreation area and the construction of a residential boating facility consisting of a fixed timber pier with a ramp that leads to a 150 SF terminal float. The proposed boating facility is to extend 35 ft seaward of the cited mean low water mark. The proposed dock is variant to RICRMP Standard 300.4.E.3.j as it is to be located closer than 25 ft from the property line extensions. Located at plat 89-2, lot 22; 110D Indigo Point Road, South Kingstown, RI.

2006-06-036 KEVIN ENGELMAN -- Construct a residential boating facility to consist of a 4'x16' fixed timber pier, a 3' x 20' ramp to a 150-square foot float. The float is proposed to be restrained by either four (4) float restraint piles or mooring anchors and chains. The terminus of the pier extends to 33-feet beyond MLW (See attached plans). Located at plat 1, lot 147; 109 Fort Avenue, Cranston RI.

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
