2006-01-087 ROBERT DARIGAN -- construct and maintain a residential boating facility consisting of a 4' x 41' fixed timber pier extending to a 4' x 20' terminal fixed L-section. The facility will extend 36' seaward of the mean low water line which is 22% (+/-) of the distance from mean low to mean low water of the breachway. (Breachway width is approximately 164', 164' x 22% = 36'). Also install two new tie off piles at the inside portion of the facility. No variances are required to RICRMP 300.4. (Recreational Boating Facility). Located at plat 1, lot 69; 834B West Beach Road, Charlestown, RI.

2005-11-073 KAREN WILLIAMS -- Construct and maintain: a residential boating facility consisting of a 4' wide by 75' long fixed timber pier that leads to a ramp that leads to a 7.5' x 20' (150 sf) terminal float. The proposed structure extends 50 feet seaward of the cited mean low water mark. Located at plat 88-1, lot 64; 12 Hartford Avenue, South Kingstown, RI

1988-05-019 PHILIP DESIATO -- Alter the design of a previously approved residential boating facility. The proposed change consist of the addition of 200 SF of terminal float and the as-built approval of an additional 13 LF of fixed pier. The proposed structure is to have a total of 340 SF of terminal float which exceeds the standard of 150 SF established in the RICRMP Section 300.4. The proposed structure is to extend a maximum of 37 feet seaward of the cited MLW mark. Located at plat 88-1, lot 63; 4 Hartford Avenue, South Kingstown, RI.
