



City of Providence Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) Submission Public Hearing

On Monday, January 4, 2016 at 5:30pm, the City of Providence Department of Planning and Development will host a public hearing allowing the general public an opportunity to comment on the municipality's full Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) submission for federal fiscal years (FFY) 2017 – 2025.

The municipality's TIP submission is a list of transportation projects that are intended to be considered by the State of Rhode Island for implementation using United States Department of Transportation funds. For a transportation project to utilize federal funds it must be included in the TIP. A project's inclusion in the TIP is a critical step, but it does not represent an allocation of funds, obligation to fund, or grant of funds.
